BIOGRAPHY

- •Christopher Edward Nolan was born on 30 July 1970, in London. His father, Brendan James Nolan, was a British advertising executive who worked as a creative director. His mother, Christina, was an American flight attendant who would later work as an English teacher.
- •He has an elder brother, Matthew, and a younger brother, Jonathan, who is also a filmmaker.
- •After earning his bachelor's degree in English literature in 1993, Nolan worked as a script reader, camera operator, and director of corporate videos and industrial films.
- •He directed, wrote and edited the short film *Larceny* (1996), which was filmed over a weekend in black and white with limited equipment and a small cast and crew. Funded by Nolan and shot with the UCLU Film society's equipment, it appeared at the Cambridge Film Festival in 1996 and is considered one of UCL's best shorts.
- •Nolan is married to Emma Thomas, whom he met at University College London when he was 19. She has worked as a producer on all of his films.










GENRE

Nolan's films are majorly centred in metaphysical themes, exploring the concepts of time, memory, and personal identity. His work is characterised by mathematically inspired ideas and images, unconventional narrative structures, materialistic perspectives, and evocative use of music and sound.






"I've always been fascinated by time, by the subjectivity of time"




Christopher Nolan is a moralist and this theme is presented in all of his movies. Nolan's work explores human morality, the nature of time, and construction of personal identity.


CINEMATOGRAPHY

- Hand-held camera work
- •Embedded narratives and crosscutting between different time frames is a major component of his work, and his films often feature experimental soundscapes and mathematically inspired images and concepts.
- Nolan prefers shooting on film to digital video and advocates for the use of higher-quality, larger-format film stock.
- •He also favours practical effects over computer-generated imagery, and is a proponent of theatrical exhibition.










EDITING

- Elliptical editing
- Montages
- Parallel Editing

These editing techniques further portray the theme of TIME within Christophers films. In Dunkirk the constant use of parallel editing shows how all the three events are linked.



MISE-EN-SCENE

- Documentary-style lighting
- Natural settings
- •Real filming locations over studio work

ATTENTION TO DETAIL:

Christopher Nolan actually planted all of this corn for the movie and once filming was complete he sold the land and corn to make profit for the film.







SOUNDTRACK

- •Hans Zimmer and Chrstopher Nolan have worked together many times to create original soundtracks for his films.
- •Hans Zimmer uses electronic sounds with orchestral arrangements achieving tension and rhythm.
- •He also uses The Shepard Tone which is an auditory illusion where two or more sound waves with different frequencies are played simultaneously.
- •All of the movies below have a soundtrack by Hans Zimmer:

On millers planet, the soundtrack in the background has a ticking sound that happens every 1.25 seconds. It's explained that every hour there, equals 7 earth years. Each tick represents

1 day on earth
