# **International Photography-in-Residence 2017**

Student numbers: 36-40 max

Themes: Family - Environment

Day 1: Meet at SJ Tue 13 June - 9:00 am

Split groups in three – a carousel

Each tutor with a group 30-45 mins – repeated 3 times (essentially like 3 classes).

A 15 mins break in between each session with smaller groups (10-12.)

Gareth Syvret – explore objects from the photo-archive
 Set students a research/ analytical task linked to the themes: Family / Environment

Jonny Briggs: explore his practice
 Set students a photographic task, e.g. produce two images over lunch.

Set students a photographic task, e.g. produce two images over lunch.

With the first workshop we want students to leave the day with some starting points and a taster of how they can use the Photographic-archive and take inspiration from how Tanja and Jonny are using the Photographic Archive as research to develop their Archisle IPR projects.
